Firearms Safety Course

Nominate via email to MRCsafety@iinet.net.au - applicants will be then given a course date and time based on first come 1st served.

A date will be confirmed dependent on sufficient numbers wanting to complete the course.

- a. Read the PDF of the **NSW Firearms (Longarms) User Guide** on our website or go to the following link - https://www.police.nsw.gov.au/data/assets/pdf_file/0014/133133/Firearms_Users_Guide.pdf
- b. Read and study the Guide prior to the commencement of the Course. Be aware there will not be any formal instruction of the theory phase apart from a session of revision exercises, which in turn will gauge the overall knowledge of each participant.
- c. Be prepared prior to commencing the course, all participants will be required to fill out a Police Form P650 in front of the Instructor to satisfy the legal requirement to be a suitable person to firstly participate in the course. Secondly, on successful completion, apply for a Firearms License. Suitable forms of photo identification will also have to be provided on the day. Minors or their parents / Guardians, may have to contact the Instructor prior to the course to ensure the proposed identification provided will satisfy the NSW Police Force.
- d. Prepayment must be made to the Murwillumbah Rifle Club prior to commencement of Course on the day. **Fees are \$160 for an Adult / \$115 for a minor (under 18).**
- e. Be in possession of suitable stationary such as a pen and paper for use during the Course. No refreshments can be provided, so it is highly recommended to bring along water, snacks, etc.
- f. All participants must be aware that all current COVID restrictions and any appropriate safety measures will be enforced during the course. Course times and dates may be moved depending NSW Governments directives/advice.
- g. The course will run over two separate sessions on the same day.
Session 1 will consist of course registration and administration, theory revision and catch up.
Expected duration 2-3 hours.

Session 2 will be formal Practical lessons and practice. The conclusion will consist of the Theory Exam followed by the Practical Assessment. Expected duration 2-3 hours.
