## FIELD / SPORTING RIFLES

In the endeavour of our club to provide shooting disciplines to further the needs of our members for competition we are introducing.

'Field - Sporting Rifles' into the F - Class Open Discipline.

Simply this means that 'Field / Sporting Rifles' can be used at longer distances.

Competitors must start with the Sunday Field Shoot showing their rifle has been zeroed in at 100 yards.

The competitor must show 10 shots grouping consistently at bullseye level (5points) or better at 100 yards

The competitor will then have the target score sheet the signed and dated by the 100 yard Range Officer.

The competitor must be able to produce the target sheet to the Range Officer on the day prior to shooting at the 300 yard mound.

When stepping up to longer shooting distances then the 300 yard mound the competitor must achieve a minimum of 21 bullseyes (5points) or better. The Range Office of the day has to agree with the skill level of the competitor prior to moving to the next level.

F Class Open comprises of two groups of competition shots;

- Round 1 = 2 sighters plus 10 counting rounds,
- Round 2 = 2 sighters plus 11 counting rounds.

Target shooters will be scored under "F-class" regulations and will be recorded and published as 'F Class Open'

Range Fees: same as Fullbore: Members \$10, Non-Members \$20,
